1.0 POLICY

- 1.1** Fire protection district elections shall be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday in November of odd-numbered years. A person may become a candidate for the office of fire commissioner by filling a declaration of candidacy with the county auditor during the July filing period as described by law. In the event that there are more than two candidates for any position of the board, a primary election shall be held on the third Tuesday of September in the manner prescribed by law. The two candidates receiving the greatest number of votes will appear on the election ballot in November.
- A person is legally qualified to become a fire commissioner who is a United States citizen, and qualified voter and resident of the fire Protection district.
